

Lion Charles Hugh Davis

1930-2008



Charles Hugh Davis, 77, of Rocky Mount, died on Thursday, April 24, 2008. He was born on December 7, 1930, in Waynesboro, Pa., to Ruth Greenawalt Davis and Hugh Theodore Davis. He was also preceded in death by a sister-in-law, Evelyn Yeatts (Cleo); and brothers-in-law, Douglas M. Haskins and Billy C. Haskins. Charles attended Texas Christian University, Letourneau University and graduated from Lynchburg College, moving to Rocky Mount after accepting a position with the Franklin County Public Schools.
